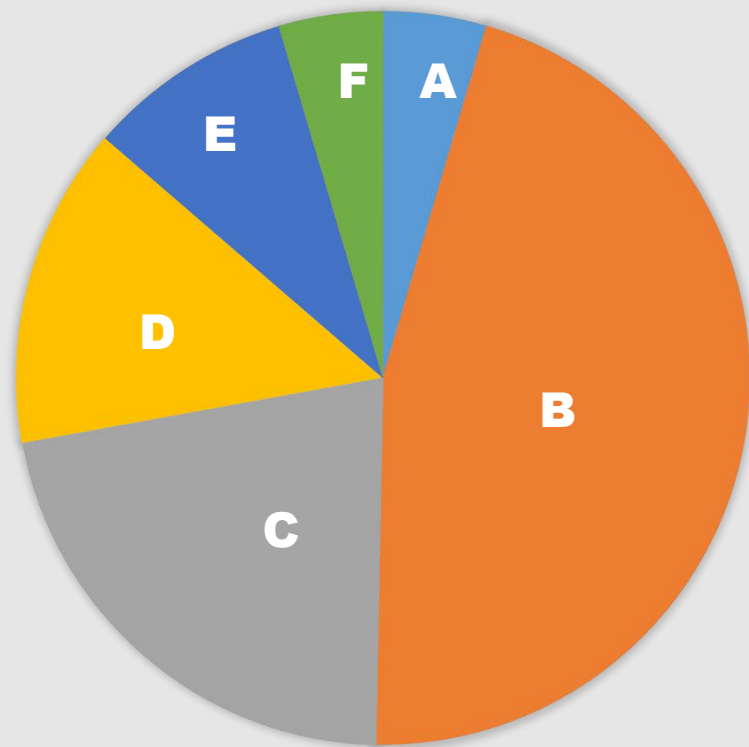

**-Total government investment for education in 2020:**

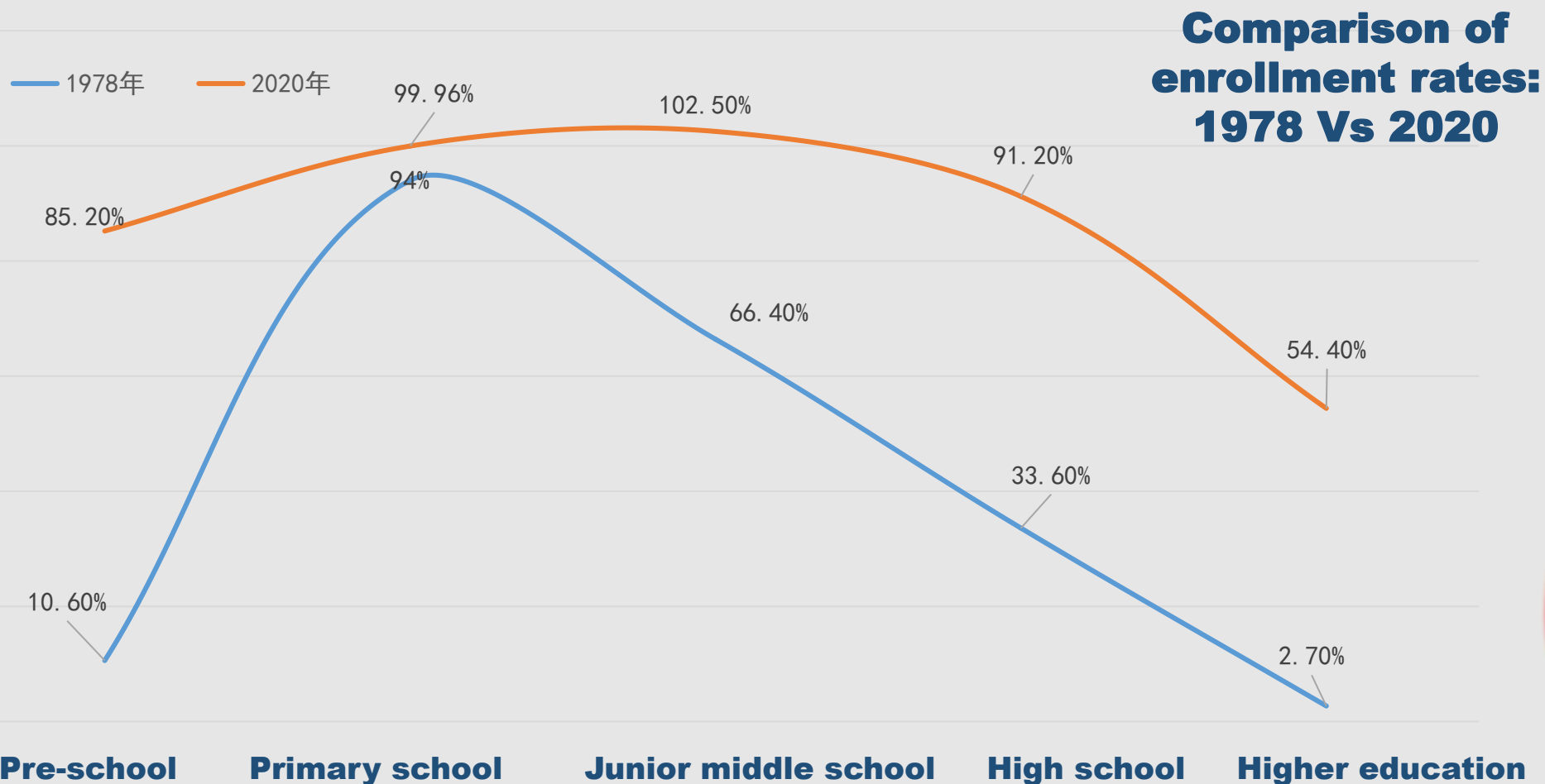
**5.3014 trillion yuan**

**->4% of annual GDP for 8 consecutive years**

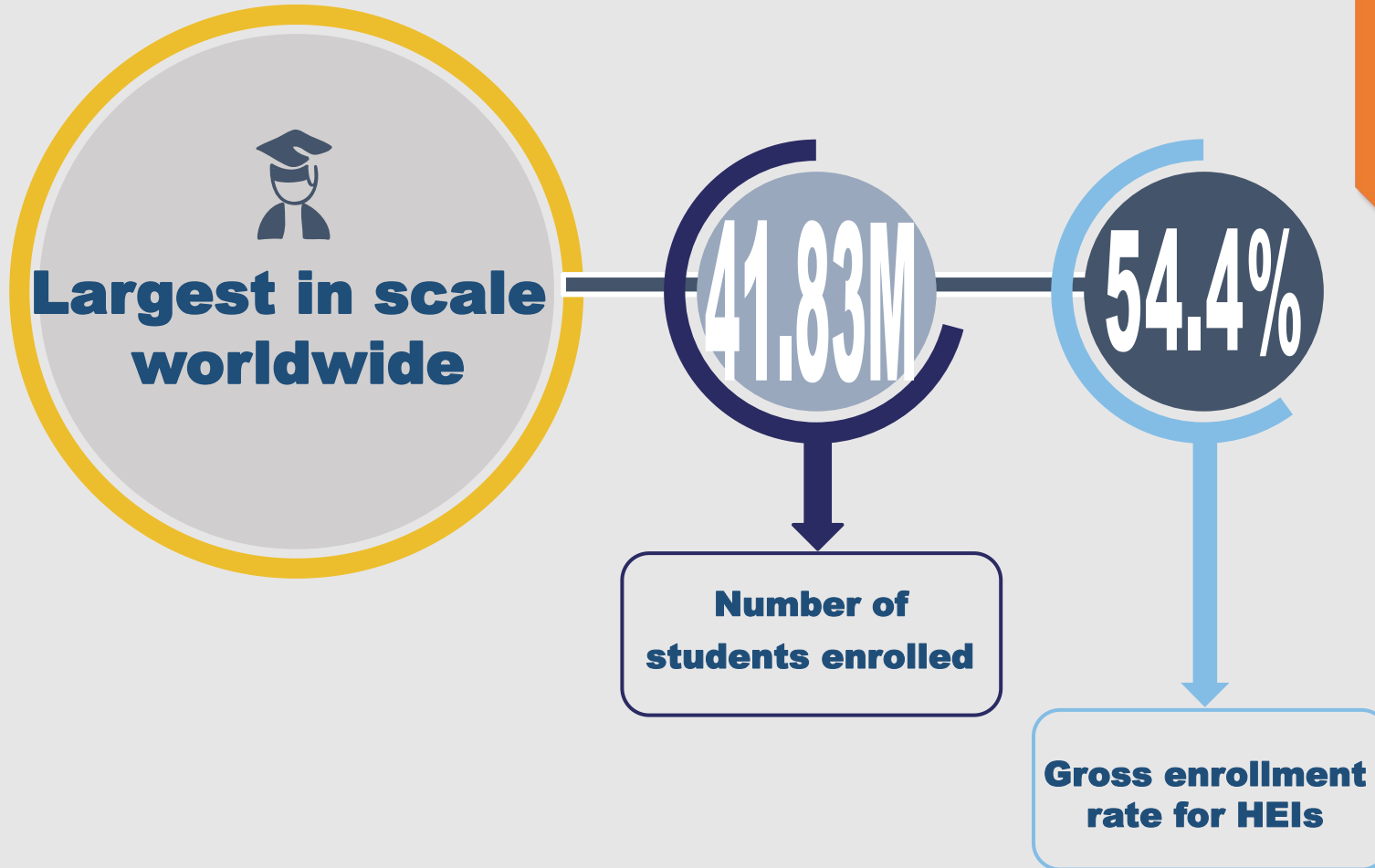
**-Ranks above the global average**

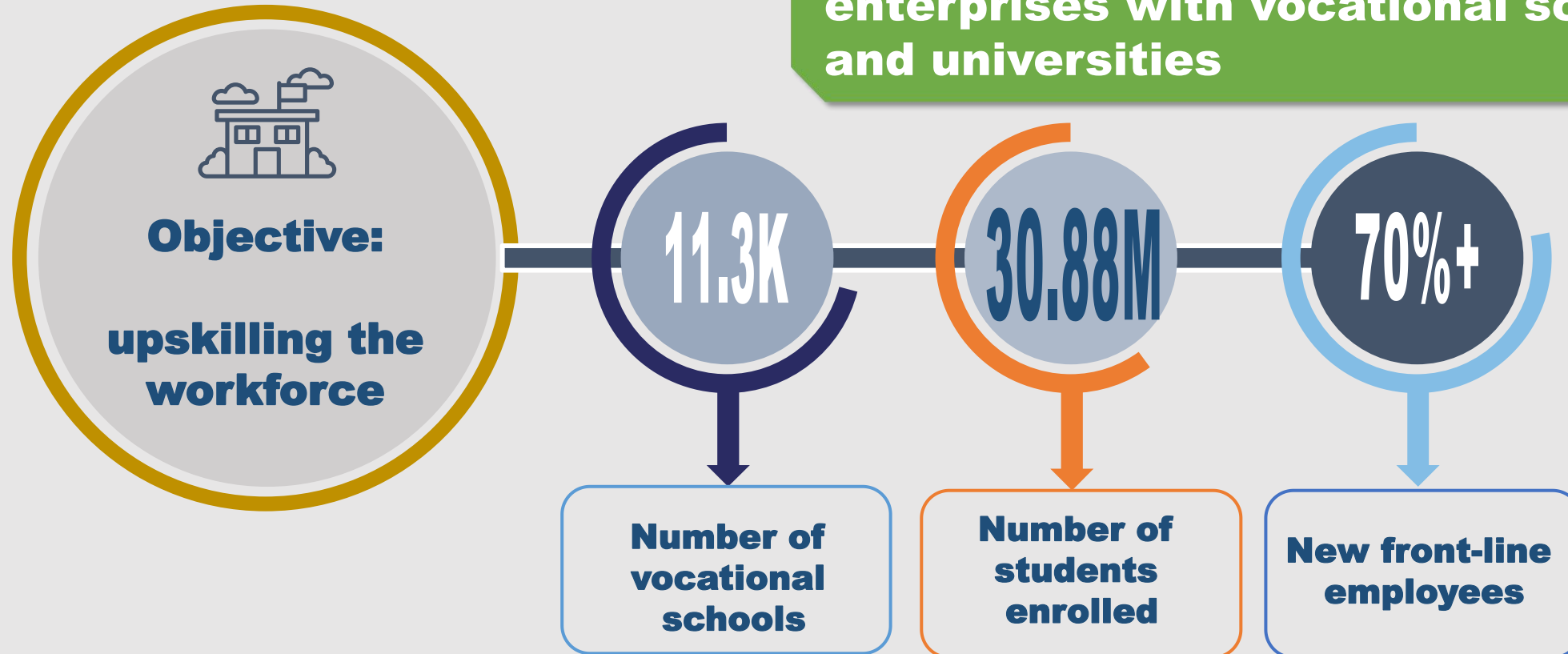

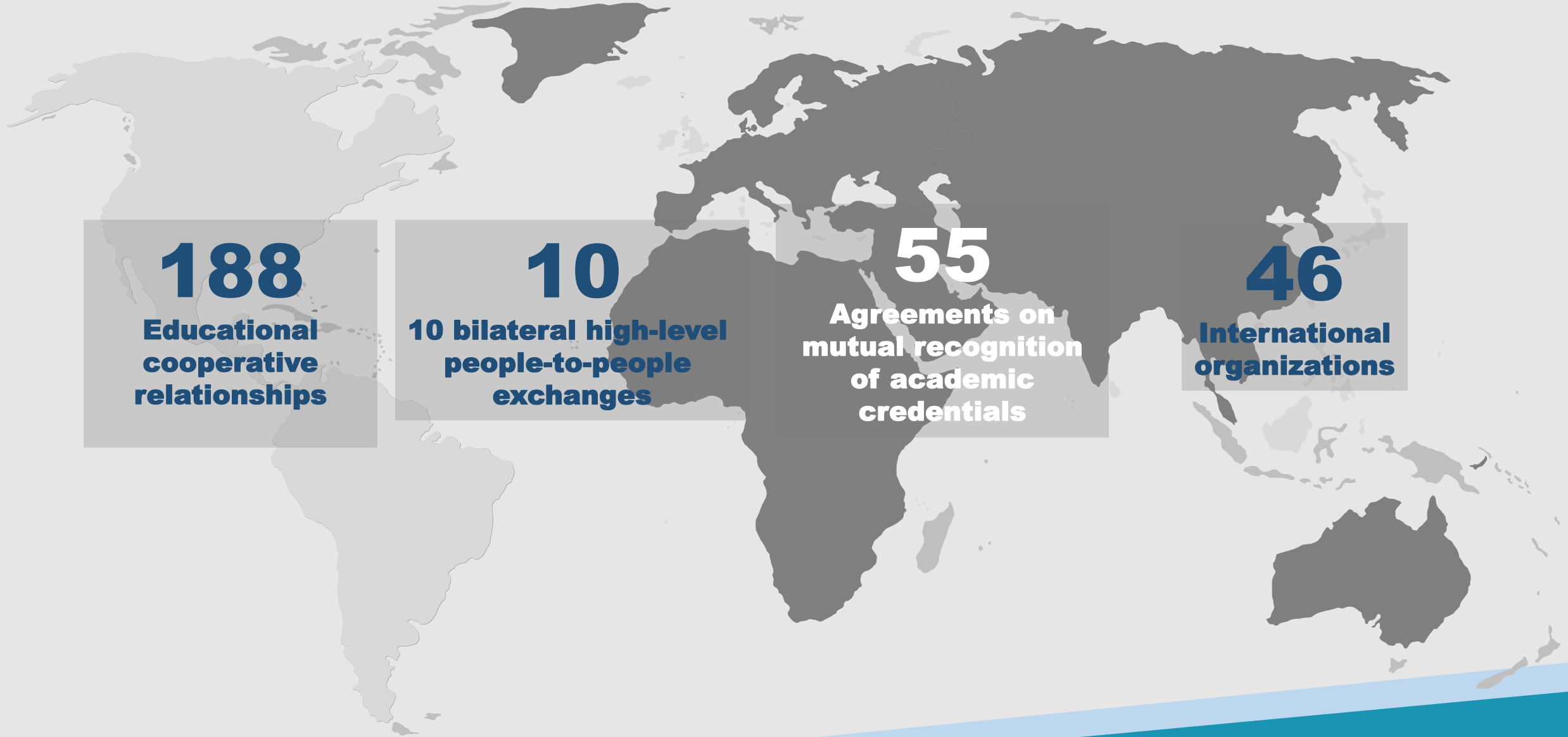
